- Will you restore and re-open the surgical, therapeutic, and diagnostic out-patient services that have been privatized from hospitals?
- Will you commit to stopping the public private partnership (P3) privatization of the new Civic Campus?
- Are they prepared to promote and fund public primary care in our Community Health Centers?
- Will they commit to creating a public non-profit homecare system?
